
Day 1 Minsk Arrival

Arrival in Minsk meeting with local, English speaking guide and transfer to hotel. Check-in at **Hotel Hotel Minsk ****** or similar. Minsk – the capital of the Republic of Belarus, its political and cultural centre. It was first mentioned in the chronicles of the XIth century. Today, it is a dynamic city with expansive boulevards, modern and historical buildings, endless parks and well developed infrastructure. Being an impressive example of the Soviet planning on a grand scale, Minsk however has a number of outstanding historical sights, proving city's rich history.



Day 2 Minsk

Breakfast buffet. 09.00 - 12.00 Visit of the city of Minsk. It includes the main avenues (Avenida de la Independencia, Avenida de la Victoria) and the architectural monuments of the 17th - 20th centuries (the High City with the Town Hall, the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit and the Cathedral of the Holy Virgin Mary, old streets of the Trinity suburb). The Victory Monument and the National Library (included in the list of the world's most prominent buildings) are waiting to be explored. Visit to the local market of Komarovka. If you are intrigued by the delicacies of the cuisine of the countries of the former Soviet Union, you must visit Komarovka, the largest market in the capital of Belarus, where you can buy and try almost anything. Free time.



Day 3 Minsk - Poleskije Tradicii - Brest

Breakfast buffet. At 09.00 hours transfer to the farm "Poleskije Tradicii" through Nesvizh, a charming historical city, one of the

oldest in the country. You will visit the magnificent Nesvizh Palace (entrance), former residence of the aristocratic family Radzivili, which also includes a beautiful park and the 16th-century Farny Roman Catholic Church. The complex once had 170 rooms, with a series of underground passages that connect it with the city's monasteries. Today, the Palace exhibition includes more than 30 exhibition halls, including Prince's apartments, Golden and Star rooms, Hunter's room and others. 14.00 Lunch at the farm "Poleskije Tradicii", the idea of ??creating farms - save the area of ??traditional Belarusian culture of the mid-twentieth century. Continue to Brest and register at Hotel Hermitage **** or similar. 20.00 dinner at the hotel restaurant.



Day 4 Brest-Beloveskaya Puscha-Brest

Breakfast buffet. At 09.00 you will have a Brest city tour. Brest is a traditional "western door" of the country. It is a quiet and relaxed city, with the famous Sovetskaya street and similar boulevards, perfect for walking. But the main attraction of the city is the Brest fortress (entrance), which of course is included in the city tour. The fortress made a prolonged defense against the Nazis in 1941 and was ruined as a result of severe battles. Only a few men had survived, but the citizens of the entire USSR had been inspired by the heroism of the defenders of the Brest fortress. Today is a giant monument that deeply affects. 12.00 departure to the Belovezhskaya Pushcha National Park (60 km from Brest). This world-famous park, included in the list of UNESCO World Heritage sites, has recently celebrated its 600th anniversary! It is one of the last and largest remaining parts of the immense primitive forest that once spread across the European plain. It is believed that some oaks here are over 600 years old! The park used to be the home and playground of the Polish princes and the Russian tsars, who spent a lot of time resting and hunting. The current world of animals and birds of Pushcha is very rich and diverse. The reserve is home to around 200 species of birds, including the nutcracker, the eagle owl, the white stork, along with 60 species of mammals, including wild boar, wild horses, wandering elk, deer and, perhaps, the most famous, the bison, which is supposed to be one of the symbols of the country. The excursion includes the Pushcha tour and the visit to the Nature Museum (entrance). Return to Brest.



Day 5 Brest - Mir - Minsk

Breakfast buffet. At 09.00 you will have your departure to Mir, which is a small town southwest of Minsk. He is most famous for the fairy tale Mir Castle (entrance), still known today as the "medieval flower". The castle is an impressive architectural monument, included in the list of World Cultural Heritage by UNESCO. It was erected at the end of the 15th century and today is a combination of Gothic, Baroque and Renaissance architecture that makes Mir Castle so unique. This red brick castle is also a historical monument, which used to belong to several aristocratic families, who have left their mark on the history of the city and the country in general. Departure transfer to Minsk airport.
